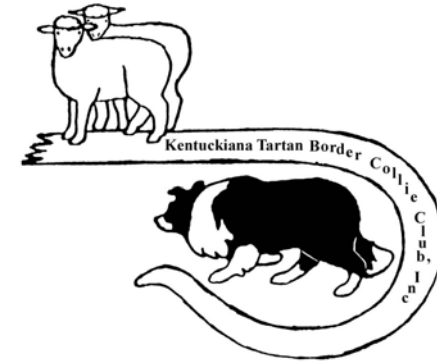

Giant Schnauzers, Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs, Standard Schnauzers, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhunds and Pyrenean Shepherds may only enter trial classes as Exhibition Only entries.

Notice to Exhibitors:

- No entries will be accepted prior to the opening date of August 1, 2009.
- The Trial site is in the Eastern Time Zone, Daylight Savings Time.
- There will be a lunch break each day at the judge's discretion.
- Please call the trial secretary before delivering a hand-carried entry.
- A handler's meeting will be held before each class. The first handler's meeting each day will be held at 8:15 a.m.
- A separate entry must be made for each dog.
- Drawing for running order will be held at the Trial Secretary's address on Wednesday, September 9, 2009 at 6:00 p.m.
- Please clean up after your dog and yourself. We ask the cooperation of exhibitors in helping to keep the trial location as clean as possible in order to be able to hold future AKC events at this facility.
- Make checks or money orders payable to the Kentuckiana Tartan Border Collie Club (KTBC). All fees are payable in U.S. Funds.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A collection fee will be added to each returned check.
- No refunds will be made for duplicated entries or errors on entry forms. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in such event.
- The Kentuckiana Tartan Border Collie Club may decline any entries and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against the Kentuckiana Tartan Border Collie Club or any official thereof.
- There shall be no refund of entry fees for dogs that are absent, retired, removed, excused or disqualified or if because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or compete in the Trial. If a dog is absent and is replaced by an alternate, then the entry fee shall be refunded.
- Entrants on the alternates list must check in with the Trial Secretary on the Trial grounds no later than 30 minutes before the commencement of their class. Alternates that do not have the opportunity to run shall have their entry fee refunded.
- Requests to move up must be given to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the event.
- Bitches in season will be permitted to run but will be placed at the end of the running order in each class.
- All dogs must be held on leash or otherwise restricted except when competing. Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena. See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the AKC Herding Regulations.
- The Kentuckiana Tartan Border Collie Club, its officers and representatives, the Trial Chair, Secretary, Committee and the owner of the Trial site assume no responsibility for loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors' property and their dogs and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Herding Tests or Trials and of the opportunity to have the dog tested or judged and to win ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Herding Tests or Trials premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other causes.

I (we) assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this Herding Test or Trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

I (we) will pay for any livestock injuries or replacement value in the event of death of any livestock by my (our) dog. In case of any injury to any stock caused by the dog entered, I (we) will assume total responsibility for any damage. I (we) agree to pay the full market value of the injured animal in case of serious injury, or the veterinarian bill if the injury is slight.
