Obstacles

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

Course Familiarization and Warm-ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of each class. The walk-through allows handlers to plan their strategy for running the course. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class.

Novice A & B dogs and handlers only will be given a familiarization period prior to the start of judging on Thursday, March 16, 2006 during which they may familiarize each of the contact obstacles. Only dogs that are not entered on the previous days may do familiarization. Dogs may work on or off lead and will perform contact obstacles one at a time. Food, training devices, and toys are not permitted in the course area.

A warm-up area, consisting of one regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may not use the warm-up area to relieve their dogs.

Notice to Exhibitor Information

* Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

*You are expected to clean up after your own dog.
 Help us remain "Good Dog Neighbors"

*The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

*It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Notice to Exhibitors cont.

- *All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when on course or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- *Judges are not required to wait for dogs. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to be judged. The club will not be responsible and is not obligated to furnish any service for notifying the exhibitors or their agents of class judging.
- It is up to the exhibitor to notify the gate of any possible conflicts.**
- * Set-up ex-pens and crates in designated areas only. Soft-sided crates are discouraged.
- *Crates, ex-pens and personal equipment may be left overnight at the owners discretion. GLTC will not be responsible for any loss or damaged items.
- *NO DOGS may be left unsupervised overnight at the agility show site.
- *Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civic authorities and/or building or location restrictions.
- *Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from the competition by action of the judge or Show Committee.
- *A refund of entry fees paid, less \$10 U.S. per dog/per day, shall be made for bitches in season, provided acceptable written documentation is furnished from a licensed veterinarian prior to the dog running.
- *No entry fee will be refunded if either or both trials cannot open, or cannot be completed, by reason of any riot, civil disturbance, terrorism, fire, earthquake, flood, storm, severe weather, Act of God, disaster, aircraft or traffic mishap or impact, epidemic, plague or disease, military action or exercise, declared or undeclared war or conflict, public emergency, act of a public enemy or criminal, or any other cause whatsoever beyond the control of the Organizing committee.
- *Faxed, telegraphed, telephoned, E-Mailed, unsigned entries or entries without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the AKC Agility entry form, are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- *No refund will be made for duplicate entries. Care will be taken to find duplicates; however, if the entry was processed NO REFUND will be made.

The trial is open to all dogs over the age of 12 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in seasons, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. 20 Inches: For dogs over 22 inches at the withers.

International Sweepstakes Classes

Purpose

The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing a dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various international style standard and jumpers courses. This competition-based class will aid in the selection process of the World Team members; therefore, the rules for this class are generally based on international rules.

Prizes

Rosettes will be awarded to First through Fourth placements in each height division.

Jump Heights

The ISC Class shall be split into three (3) separate categories; Mini Agility for dogs measuring 13-3/4" and/or less at the withers, Midi Agility for dogs measuring 16-7/8" at the withers and/or less, and Maxi Agility for dogs measuring greater than 16-7/8" at the withers. As indicated in the equipment specifications for the ISC Class, dogs entered in Mini Agility jump 14" in height, dogs entered in Midi Agility jump 18" in height, dogs entered in Maxi Agility jump 26" in height. Exceptions and/or ranges exist at some jumps, see "Obstacle Specifications."

Eligibility of Dogs

These classes are only open to dogs that are eligible to compete in both Excellent Standard and Excellent Jumpers with Weaves.

- * Separate entry forms are required for ISC
- * Separate checks are required for entry fees for each dog entered in ISC
- * Entry fee \$25 is inclusive for both Jumpers ISC held on Friday March 17th and Standard ISC held on Saturday March 18th.
- * Jumpers ISC will be held after completion of the Excellent Jumpers class on Friday March 17th
- * Standard ISC will be held after completion of the Excellent Standard class on Saturday March 18th
- * Ring size will be at least 8,000 square feet
