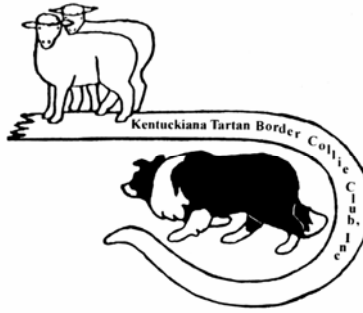


Tartan Tails



December 13, 2003 Meeting Minutes:

KTbcc members will bring snacks. Participants need to bring their own beverages and chair. We will consider doing other Fun Day activities in the Summer after our Spring activities are over.
