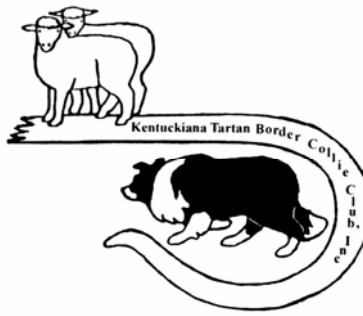


Tartan Tails



October 11, 2003 Meeting Minutes:

Minutes from August Meeting: Motion made by Ronni to accept the minutes, 2nd by Nancy. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Mary Somerville reported that we now have \$928.41 in our treasury. This includes paying \$50 for our March Trial AKC application fee; Outstanding costs – Calendars that are being taken to the Nationals to sell; Afgan for raffle for March Trial. We are already committed to supporting the Sunday trial so it was decided to NOT support the Monday Show. Ronni is getting ribbons and Denise Morris is doing trophies.
